Costs for the designation shall be paid by private donations (Section 227.822);</p> <p>(2) "Dr Dan Brown Memorial Highway" in Phelps County. Costs for the designation shall be paid by private donations (Section 227.839);</p> <p>(3) "Celia Memorial Highway" in Callaway County. Costs for the designation shall be paid by private donations (Section 227.840);</p> <p>(4) "Police Chief Mason Griffith Memorial Highway" in Gasconade County.
