HB 1437 -- FIREARMS

SPONSOR: Gallick

This bill modifies current law so that a person commits the offense of unlawful use of a weapon if he or she knowingly discharges or shoots a firearm:

- (1) At or from a motor vehicle, unless discharged from a stationary vehicle as authorized under the Missouri wildlife code;
- (2) At any person; at any other self-propelled vehicle; or at any building or habitable structure. (Section 571.030)

The bill also establishes Blair's Law, which states that a person commits the offense of unlawful discharge of a firearm if, with criminal negligence, he or she discharges a firearm within or into the limits of any municipality.

This bill does not apply if a person discharges a firearm under the circumstances specified in the bill.

This bill is similar to HB 109(2023).
