HB 1459 -- DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS LICENSE PLATES

SPONSOR: Sharpe (4)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Standing Committee on Transportation Infrastructure by a vote of 10 to 0. Voted "Do Pass- Consent" by the Standing Committee on Consent and House Procedure by a vote of 6 to 0.

This bill changes the requirements as to how a Disabled American Veterans special license plate must look by removing the specific requirements and requiring only an emblem and slogan of the Disabled American Veterans organization.

This bill is the same as HB 1067 (2023).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this change was requested by disabled veterans.

Testifying in person for the bill was Representative Sharpe.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
