HB 1507 -- MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIRS

SPONSOR: Bangert

This bill requires that prior to repairing or performing maintenance on a motor vehicle, the person or business performing the repairs or maintenance must verify that the vehicle's registration is current under Section 301.020, RSMo. If the motor vehicle registration is not current, the repairs or maintenance work cannot be performed.

Failure to verify that the motor vehicle registration is current can result in a fine of up to \$300 per violation.

The registration verification requirement and fine will not apply if the motor vehicle is being repaired to comply with the motor vehicle safety inspection requirements under Chapter 307.
