HCS HB 1534 -- QUALIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC OFFICE

SPONSOR: Baringer

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Special Committee on Election Contests by a vote of 5 to 0. Voted to "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 8 to 0.

The following is a summary of the House Committee Substitute for HB 1534.

This bill requires any person who files as a candidate for a public office that performs county functions in the City of St. Louis to provide copies of paid receipts or no-tax-due statements for local personal and real property taxes received from the Assessor to the election authority.

This bill is the same as HB 102 (2023).

The following is a summary of the public testimony from the committee hearing. The testimony was based on the introduced version of the bill.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this addition is necessary to close a loophole in the law that allows candidates for certain offices in the City of St. Louis to file for office without having to provide necessary paid receipts or no-tax-due statements required of candidates for other offices.

Testifying in person for the bill were Representative Baringer; and Ben Borgmeyer, St. Louis City Election Board.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
