HB 1664 -- ESTABLISHMENT OF HOSPITALS

SPONSOR: Peters

Currently, with the exception of counties of the third and fourth classification where there already exists a hospital organized under Chapter 96, 205, or 206, RSMo, county commissions are authorized to establish, construct, equip, improve, extend, repair, and maintain public hospitals, engage in health care activities, and issue bonds.

This bill removes the exception for hospitals established under the provisions of Chapters 96 and 206 in counties of the third and fourth classification.

This bill is similar to HB 1239 (2023).
