HB 1673 -- RADIOACTIVE WASTE INVESTIGATION FUND

SPONSOR: Matthiesen

Currently, the General Assembly can transfer up to \$150,000 to the Radioactive Waste Investigation Fund to be used by the Department of Natural Resources to investigate concerns of exposure to radioactive waste.

This bill specifies that the investigation may include collection of soil, dust, and water samples from the area. The bill also increases the amount of money the General Assembly can transfer to the fund from the Hazardous Waste Fund to \$300,000 and limits the expenditures per fiscal year to \$300,000 transfered from the Hazardous Waste Fund and any additional General Revenue appropriated.
