

HB 1953 -- STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

SPONSOR: Cook

This bill modifies provisions relating to the State Advisory Council on Emergency Medical Services.

The bill increases the amount of council members from 16 to a maximum of 23, removes the requirement that one member shall be a resident of a city not within a county, and updates the criteria for member appointment. This bill also changes the procedure for electing a chairperson by removing the designation of the chairperson by the Governor and instead requiring the council to elect the chairperson or any other officer as deemed necessary.

This bill also removes a provision stating that the regional EMS advisory committees are to serve as resources for identifying potential members of the council.
