HB 2084 -- CONSOLIDATED PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICTS

SPONSOR: Banderman

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Standing Committee on Government Efficiency and Downsizing by a vote of 8 to 0. Voted "Do Pass- Consent" by the Standing Committee on Consent and House Procedure by a vote of 8 to 0.

This bill allows the board of trustees for consolidated public library districts to modify the existing district's fiscal year from July 1 to June 30 to a different set of dates. The budget shall still be approved before the end of the fiscal year set by the board.

This bill is similar to HB 437 (2023).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill will allow the library district to adjust its fiscal year, providing it with a better way to budget for the year and save interest money on bonds.

Testifying in person for the bill was Representative Banderman.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
