HB 2182 -- NONOPIOID PAMPHLETS

SPONSOR: Stinnett

This bill requires the Department of Health and Senior Services to develop and publish an educational pamphlet regarding the use of nonopioid alternatives for pain management, including pharmacological and non-pharmacological treatments, as well as the associated advantages and disadvantages. The information in the pamphlet is required to conform to the most current clinical practice guideline for opioid prescription issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Before January 1, 2025, and every two years thereafter, the Department is required to distribute the most updated version of the pamphlet to local public health agencies and other health-related organizations.
