HB 2280 -- PRACTICE OF DENTISTRY

SPONSOR: Veit

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Standing Committee on Professional Registration and Licensing by a vote of 13 to 0. Voted "Do Pass- Consent" by the Standing Committee on Consent and House Procedure by a vote of 6 to 0.

Currently, corporations cannot practice dentistry unless that corporation is a nonprofit corporation or a professional corporation under Missouri law. This bill exempts entities contracted with the state to provide care in correctional centers.

This bill is similar to SB 1287 (2024).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this would allow correction centers to have more access to dental care.

Testifying in person for the bill were Representative Veit; and Centurion.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
