HB 2590 -- PUBLIC SAFETY SALES TAX

SPONSOR: Falkner

This bill authorizes any city with more that 51,000 but fewer that 58,000 inhabitants and located in more that one county, upon voter approval, to impose a sales tax of up to .05% for the purpose of improving the public safety of the city, limited to expenditures on equipment, salaries and benefits, and facilities for police, fire, and emergency medical providers.

Upon enactment, the bill will add the City of Joplin.
