

HB 2709 -- AGE OF MARRIAGE

SPONSOR: Dinkins

Currently, no marriage license can be issued in Missouri for individuals under 16 years of age or issued when one party to the marriage is under 18 years of age and the other party over 21 years of age. Additionally, no marriage license can be issued if any party to the marriage is under 18 years of age without parental consent.

This bill repeals those provisions and provides that no marriage license will be issued in Missouri for individuals under 18 years of age.

This bill is the same as SCS SB 767 & 1342 (2024).
