HB 2854 -- RECORDING OF LAND SURVEYS

Currently, a surveyor must file certain land surveys with county recorders of deeds within 60 days after the survey is certified. This bill allows a surveyor to file the survey results with the Department of Agriculture's Land Survey Program instead. However, a survey filed with the Land Survey Program may not be evidence in any court unless the survey result was also filed with the recorder and properly certified.
