

HB 2900 -- REPRODUCTIVE OR SEXUAL HEALTH APPLICATION INFORMATION

SPONSOR: Woods

This bill prohibits the sharing, selling, or use of any "reproductive or sexual health application information" by a "reproductive or sexual health digital service", as both terms are defined in the bill, for any purpose without obtaining affirmative consent from the consumer for each instance of sharing, selling, or using the information.

A government entity is prohibited from requiring a reproductive or sexual health digital service from releasing any application information, except for the purpose of a criminal investigation, as specified in the bill.

In order for reproductive or sexual health application information to be released to a government entity without the affirmative consent of the consumer, certain conditions must be satisfied, which are specified in the bill.

This bill is similar to HB 2245 (2024).
