

HB 2935 -- TASK FORCE ON MARKETING OF CANNABIS AND CANNABINOID PRODUCTS

This bill establishes the "Task Force on the Marketing of Cannabis and Cannabinoid Products to Children and Pregnant Women", and provides that membership is composed of one member of the State House of Representatives; one member of the State Senate; a pediatrician; a physician that specializes in obstetrics and gynecology; a maternal-fetal medicine physician; a neonatologist; a public health expert; a public safety expert; a representative of the Department of Health and Senior Services; a representative of the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education; and a representative of the Department of Transportation.

The Task Force will study current marketing efforts of cannabis and cannabinoid products to children and pregnant women and make recommendations on how this marketing should be further regulated and restricted.

Before September 1, 2025, and before every September 1 thereafter, the Task Force must submit an annual report of its activities from the preceding fiscal year to the Governor and General Assembly.
