HCR 42 -- MISSOURI AND TAIWAN CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

SPONSOR: Morse

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Small Business by a vote of 5 to 2. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 5 to 0 and 1 present.

Missouri commends Taiwan's democracy and supports further strengthening of Missouri-Taiwan trade relations and academic exchanges.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that Missouri has had a relationship between its legislature and Taiwan for several years. Taiwan is a major importer of Missouri soybeans, and a major exporter of semiconductors.

Testifying in person for the bill was Representative Morse.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
