HJR 90 -- THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

SPONSOR: Myers

Upon voter approval, beginning with the 2030 decennial census, this resolution changes the number of members in the Missouri House of Representatives from 163 to 103.

Currently, members of the General Assembly can serve no more than eight years total in any one chamber of the legislature, nor more than sixteen years total in both chambers.

Upon voter approval, Beginning January 1, 2032, this resolution removes the single chamber prohibition, allowing members of the General Assembly to serve no more than 16 years total in either chamber of the legislature.

Beginning January 1, 2032, Members of the House of Representatives are prohibited from serving as Speaker or Speaker Pro Tem of the House for more than three consecutive terms. Members of the Senate are prohibited from serving as President Pro Tem of the Senate for more than two consecutive terms.
