

HJR 119 -- CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

Upon voter approval, this resolution makes numerous changes to the process of adopting Constitutional amendments.

The resolution allows voters in each Congressional district to have the opportunity to review and comment on all initiative petitions proposing amendments to the Constitution in a process administered by the Secretary of State in a public forum.

This resolution specifies that only citizens of the United States who are residents of the state of Missouri and properly registered to vote shall be considered legal voters.

Currently, Constitutional amendments require a simple majority of the votes cast in order to pass. This resolution changes that threshold for passage to 55% of the votes cast.

This bill is the same as HJR 43 (2023).
