

HJR 186 -- LAMBERT-ST. LOUIS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Currently, under Article VI, Section 30(a) of the Missouri Constitution, the people of the City of St. Louis and St. Louis County have the power to establish a metropolitan district for the functional administration of services common to the area, and to formulate and adopt a plan for the government of all or any part of the city and the county. This power is to be exercised by a vote of the people of the city and county to adopt a plan prepared by a board of freeholders.

This House Joint Resolution extends to the people of the State the power to establish a regional district for the functional administration and management of the Lambert-St. Louis International Airport and to formulate and adopt a plan for the governance of the airport. The power will be exercised by a statewide vote upon a plan as provided by legislature.
