

SCR 22 -- MISSIONS OF INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION

SPONSOR: Carter

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Higher Education by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 6 to 0.

This Senate Concurrent Resolution approves the statewide mission designation expansion for Missouri Southern State University to include Health and Life Sciences and Immersive Learning Experiences.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this focus is a strategic area that is important to the State and that there is no infringement on other institutions. The Missouri Southern State University has the most undergraduate programs in health and life sciences in the state and all of these programs are of the highest quality with 100% pass percentage on certificate programs. This focus will allow the university to provide realistic learning environments across and beyond the physical campus.

Testifying in person for the bill were Senator Carter; Jim Foley, Missouri Southern State University; and Shellie R. Hewitt, Missouri Southern State University.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
