Please find below a letter of support from St. Louis City Public Safety Director Charles Coyle outlining his support for the passage of Blair's Law: As the Director of Public Safety for the City of St. Louis, I write to support HB 1437 & HB 1477. While crime is falling in the City of St. Louis, the use of firearms remains a significant concern. Over 90 percent of the homicides committed in the St. Louis region are committed by firearm. Blair's Law would provide that a person commits the new offense of "unlawful discharge of a firearm" if, with criminal negligence, they discharge a firearm within or into the limits of a municipality, including into the air. This is an important step in the right direction to mitigate the harm of stray bullets in our City.In 2024, the number of homicides in St. Louis fell by 21 percent and Part I crimes overall are down by 22 percent. While these reductions are significant, it does not lessen our urgency to save lives. If you visit St. Louis, particularly on the Fourth of July or New Years, you have likely heard the celebratory gunfire that peppers the noise of the night celebrations. This gunfire does not come without consequences. This proposal is named for the tragic loss of Blair Shanahanlane in the Kansas City area. St. Louis does not stand apart from this type of tragedy. During New Years celebrations this year, our Police Department recorded 501 shots fired from December 31st to 2 am on 1/1/24. The previous year, this number stood at 324.1Right now, state law prohibits the "unlawful discharge of a weapon" (571.030, RSMo.) when that weapon is fired into a building or vehicle. It also provides for specific instances in which "unlawful discharge" occurs, such as within a certain distance from certain kinds of buildings and on highways. "Blair's Law" provides that "unlawful discharge" includes celebratory. In 2023 and in 2024, the St. Louis Metropolitan Police seized over 2,600 firearms in St. Louis pursuant to the commission of a crime. The guns seized included over 120 so-called "ghost guns" during that same time period. We can do more to protect our residents with the passage of HB 1437 & HB 1477 and I encourage you to support it. As a boy, my father taught me the four universal laws of gun safety.1. Treat every firearm as if it is loaded.2. Never point the muzzle at anything you are not willing to destroy.3. Be sure of your target, AND what is behind it.He told me that if I followed these laws religiously, and treated every firearm I touched with respect, but not fear, they would be powerful tools for hunting, self-defense, and recreational enjoyment. I have since taught those same rules to my own children, and enforced them strictly everywhere we go. The act of raising a firearm into the air haphazardly and firing at random in some sort of sick "celebration" is a disgrace to every law-abiding gun owner in America. That kind of recklessness perpetuates the stereotype of the ignorant gun-nut perpetuated by the gun control lobby, and this bill will address that specific behavior, without going too far. It will codify what is already criminal behavior, in my opinion, and will give law enforcement the ability to do something about this morally bankrupt behavior. Thank you.
