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Missourians for Transportation Investment (MFTI) supports the language in HB 1524 that would require a mandatory minimum fine of \$1000 for endangerment of a highway worker, \$5000 for aggravated endangerment of a highway worker if a worker is injured, and \$10,000 if a worker is killed. HB 1524 also ensures that striking a truck- or trailer-mounted attenuator (TMA) constitutes endangerment of a highway worker. MFTI is supportive of this provision within the bill as well. Protecting the safety of those who work on Missouri highways is an important priority for MFTI and its membership. We would like to thank the bill sponsor for including this language in HB 1524.
