I myself have been threatened by my local school (Reeds Spring in 2008 or 2009) when I refused to sign the optional form. I was told it was required and that if I didn't sign it then they would call the sheriff on me. The school employees couldn't even understand the word "optional", even after it was pointed out to them. I had to hire a lawyer to cease and desist the harassment by the school to sign the form. This repeal would be a huge win for the homeschool community.
