Too many children and adults alike go missing in and are missing from Missouri. Most people in our communities and throughout this state are neither aware of the number of people missing nor do they know what those that are missing "look like" since numerous missing persons are only represented by silhouettes... #WeCantFindThoseWeCantSee Did you know that some flvers on the Missouri State Highway Patrol (MSHP) website have details concerning missing persons cases but NO IMAGES or PHOTOS to help the public assist with identifying those that are missing? THIS IS RIDICULOUS and a shame! MSHP is not responsible for this intentional negligence. Maybe it's the fault of heartless, lazy, and uninterested individuals that work for our investigating agencies. Or maybe the police department representatives working on these cases want to do more but their superiors won't allow them to do what is just and proper. Whatever the case investigating agencies fail to provide the Missouri State Highway Patrol with images of a plethora of missing persons. On many occasions, this is because those taking missing person reports and handing these cases simply don't ask individuals and families for a picture of their missing loved ones. If we really care for those in Missouri and individuals that come and go though this Show-Me state, we will make sure we are doing all we can in our capacities to address the missing persons epidemic and support those with missing loved ones. We must educate law enforcement about NAMUS, missing person legislation and expectations, and work collaboratively with missing persons organization, like Looking for an Angel, Inc., and members of the community. We also must hold police departments and law enforcement agencies accountable and demand that they do all they can to publicize and locate missing persons in our state. We also need to make sure the public is aware of unidentified persons on the NAMUS website. Missouri has a lot of work to do support the missing and their loved ones. This legislation is essential and provides help and hope to those with missing loved ones. I'm grateful this bill has come this far and I look forward to celebrating the passage of the same with individuals in our state of Missouri and beyond.
