January 31, 2024Renew Missouri Advocates, Inc. 915 East AshColumbia, Missouri 65201Re: Written Testimony to the House Utilities Committee on House Bill 1746 To the Chairman and Members of the House Utilities Committee, Renew Missouri, a 501(c)(3) organized to promote clean energy policy, wishes to testify in support of House Bill 1746. Specifically, we support the section applying retroactive property tax assessments to solar equipment without reservation. This will provide regulatory certainty to those seeking to developer independent power solutions in our state. But we would also urge this body to expand the language so the concept in the current text involving the assignment of RECs to apply more broadly to businesses throughout Missouri. Allowing corporations to retain RECs - or "renewable energy credits" - could and should be a powerful economic development tool to attract and retain businesses. Historically, RECs are retained by the utility that generates renewable energy, which can sell these RECs in the marketplace. For a long time, it made sense for utility companies to retain these credits because they were the only parties with a vested interest in them. But now, industrial and commercial customers are becoming more and more connected to renewable energy. Companies have sustainability goals. Shareholders are demanding business leaders embrace the clean energy future. Corporations are selecting locations for facilities where renewable energy access is guaranteed. To meet this demand for clean energy, utilities in Missouri will produce renewable energy specifically for a certain customer or facility, with the approval of PSC regulators. Examples of this include a recent decision by the PSC to approve solar arrays for several Ameren corporate customers - including Wal-Mart. Many of these corporate customers stated they would have relocated outside of Missouri if the solar projects were not approved. While this legislation targets specific customers on the western side of the state, Renew Missouri sees the larger benefit of HB 1746. Offering large-scale customers the ability to retain RECs for the energy produced at their behest is yet another opportunity for businesses to embrace clean energy. This opportunity could be presented as part of a larger package of incentives to recruit and retain large-scale customers to do business in Missouri. Any opportunity to make renewable energy a plus for business is something this Legislature should embrace. In sum, I urge this Committee to reconsider the existing language and expand the concept in terms of RECS and allowing all Missouri businesses can take advantage. In terms of the property tax assessment portion of this bill, we urge you to pass that without revision. With respect, James OwenExecutive Director, Renew Missouri

I am an attorney in Poplar Bluff, Missouri. Since 1996, my practice has focused upon working withcitizens to form rural water and sewer districts. I donated legal services to help create the MissouriAssociation of Sewer Districts and to draft the legislation that ultimately was amended and passed bythe Legislature allowing the formation of reorganized common sewer districts throughout the state. One of the sections that was removed when the bill originally passed was the provision for payment ofBoard members. This bill is needed as it has become increasingly difficult to find quality boardmembers to serve without pay. The bill is similar to the payment provisions for water district boardmembers contained in Section 247.060.5 RSMo. I can tell you that the caliber of board members for mywater district clients has improved since this provision became law. I think the same would be true forsewer districts as well. The majority of the boards I represent go above and beyond the call of duty toserve. This attendance fee would help compensate them for just some of the time spent on behalf oftheir communities. I recommend that the bill be passed. I am unable to attend the hearing in person, but I am willing to discuss this with any of the committee members in detail at your convenience.
