I submit this testimony in strong support of HB1814, particularly the section (650.900) relating to establishing the "Missouri Task Force on Nonprofit Safety and Security" within the department of public safety office of homeland security, and the section (650.910) relating to creating the "Supplemental Nonprofit Safety and Security Fund" in the state treasury. I work in a nonprofit serving the greater Kansas City area (Jewish Federation of Greater Kansas City) and I serve on the board of a different nonprofit (Reach Out and Read Kansas City) serving the metro area as well. The risk of attacks on specific nonprofits--based on their missions, advocacy areas or the issues they focus on--is real, and we have seen violent incidents occur at such organizations in the KC metro area in the past. I have personally been involved in fundraising to bolster the security of Jewish community nonprofit organizations, and the costs involved with doing so are considerable (well into the hundreds of thousands of dollars for planning, threat assessments, physical and technological enhancements, and training). This bill and the establishment of this task force and related fund would benefit many organizations and communities in the state of Missouri, keeping people and communities safe and showing the concern of the state government for the wellbeing of its residents and social service/public benefit organizations.

I submit this testimony on behalf of the professional and volunteer leadership of the Jewish Federation of Greater Kansas City in strong and unwavering support of HB1814, particularly the section (650.900) relating to establishing the "Missouri Task Force on Nonprofit Safety and Security" within the department of public safety office of homeland security, and the section (650.910) relating to creating the "Supplemental Nonprofit Safety and Security Fund" in the state treasury. Being located at the Jewish Community Campus in Overland Park, Kansas--yet serving the Jewish community throughout the Kansas City metro area, including holding events at partner organization facilities in Missouri--we are unfortunately all too familiar with threats and attacks against our facilities and community. Nearly 10 years ago I was on my way to our facility in Overland Park when a man shot and killed two people in the parking lot, and then drove to another Jewish institution nearby and shot and killed a third person. As a community, many of our Jewish nonprofit organizations have since applied for and received federal nonprofit security grants from the Department of Homeland Security, working through the local Highway Patrol and/or the Department of Public Safety and Office of Homeland Security. However, the funding received does not even approach covering costs for security planning, threat assessments, physical and technological enhancements, and training. The Jewish Federation alone is spending more than half a million dollars annually on security on behalf of the greater Kansas City Jewish community--that does not include the real and significant costs of our partner agencies and congregations in Missouri (or Kansas). That also does not account for costs associated with the more dynamic threat environment and need for additional security following the Hamas terror organization's attacks on Israel on Oct. 7, 2023. Having a task force and related funding at the state level to address this vitally important nonprofit security need is something that is long overdue--at least 10-12 other states already have taken similar action, including Illinois, Ohio and Tennessee. Therefore we strongly advocate for the passage of HB1814, establishing the "Missouri Task Force on Nonprofit Safety and Security" and the creation and critical funding of the "Supplemental Nonprofit Safety and Security Fund" in the state treasury. We would be honored if called upon to have a representative on the task force or to recommend a representative from a partner agency, or even to attend and speak at any future task force meetings. As a member of the Kansas City Jewish community and a Jewish nonprofit professional (I have worked for Jewish Federation of Greater Kansas City since 2018) I have seen the continued need for security for Jewish spaces, whether it be synagogues, offices or communal spaces. That need has only increased since the Oct. 7 attack by Hamas on Israel, as antisemitic incidents in the US have risen almost 400%.
