Seniors, veterans and low-income home owners are being taxed out of their homes due to increased assessments. Also, tax increases on commercial property are being passed on to consumers as a cost of business. HB1906 is a bill that will require that a property not be assessed above its purchase price for as long as it belongs to the same owner. The purchase price is the fair market value, without question, and we do not tax unrealized gains in this country (except for property, and we should stop!) This applies to people of all ages (so, no constitutional problems), and all properties, including commercial. Real Property Taxes on commercial property is simply passed on to consumers as a cost of business, and failure to include commercial properties ignores the huge amounts paid unknowingly by everyone. Gentrification of cities would no longer be an issue. Because this bill does not change the function of the assessors, no amendment to the Constitution is required. (it is the fair and right thing to do!!)
