This bill deals with serious drug offenses regarding the delivery/distribution, manufacture and trafficking of drugs in protected areas. There is no logical reason to treat violators different based on the age of the violator or the age of the person receiving the illegal drugs. This bill would minimize the seriousness of these offenses, especially at a time when we have ongoing major problems (overdoses and death) from the distribution/delivery, manufacture and trafficking of methamphetamine and				

fentanyl. We certainly do not need to encourage any delivery/distribution/manufacture/trafficking of drugs by any person near schools, colleges, parks, and other protected areas by anyone. Finally, we should not have multiple ages for criminal liability for criminal offenses. These offenses should not be treated differently than the rest of the criminal code.
