I reside in Ozark, Missouri, a town that has rapidly grown over the past decade. With that growth has come new residential and commercial developments and an increase in traffic congestion. Christian County, the City of Ozark, and MoDOT have taken great pains to help alleviate the traffic congestion and improve safety around Ozark and along US 65, but as the area continues to grow, so will those traffic needs. Nonrate utilities (which I take to mean those utilities whose prices are not regulated by the state, and therefore are able to change their prices in response to costs), have also laid their lines along public right of way to serve this growth. It is my understanding that they have the right to use this right of way and cannot be required to pay for its use. Why must I, and all the taxpayers in the city I live in, the county I live in, and the state of Missouri, pay for a telecommunications company to move out of the way of important public improvements? The right of way's primary use is to help people get to and from different places. Why must improvements serving that primary use result in costs payable directly to a company that is using that space for free, especially when they could increase their prices or cut other costs to pay for it? I do not believe that socializing the costs of a private company to move cables is appropriate, and it will particularly punish small towns around the state who are simply trying to do right by their citizens.
