I OPPOSE HB 2210 as originally drafted. I think the following proposed added language should be removed: "or the person fleeing does so by operating a motor vehicle". I'm concerned that the term "fleeing" would be attributed to someone "failing to yield" (not immediately pulling over) due to continuing to drive with the intent of pulling over at a safer spot down the road, such as the nearest exit ramp, parking lot, or wide shoulder.
