Dear Mister Chair. My name is Elly Smith, I am currently a senior studying Chemical Engineering at the University of Missouri. I am testifying on my experience as a student within a STEM field and how HB2313 holds immense significance for students across all UM System campuses. Within the College of Engineering. I hold many roles that provide me with a unique perspective on the student experience. These include President of the Engineering Student Council (ESC), Freshman Peer Mentor, Tutor, member of Omega Chi Epsilon, and previous president of the American Institute of Chemical Engineers. Relating to my aforementioned role as President of ESC, my organization is responsible for organizing the bi-annual Dean's Forum. This is an opportunity for students to voice concerns regarding their experience as engineering students. For the past two years, there has only been one consistent concern I hear at each forum: tuition. As my senior year began, the College of Engineering restructured and implemented a new tuition model that increased the cost of attending Mizzou for nearly all engineering students. This was a shock to the engineering community. Students who previously thought they could afford their tuition became painfully aware they could not. This included my younger brother, a freshman engineering student at Mizzou. I have spoken with countless students who share this experience. The University often advocates for scholarship applications but there are not enough. Every scholarship added is a crucial lifeline for a student. It's an opportunity for students like my younger brother, the freshman I mentor, members of my organizations, and students throughout STEM majors alike. HB2313 holds this capability to make an impact. Thank you for considering the perspectives of students statewide on this critical issue.
