By concealing the identities and locations of major water users, this bill would hinder regulatory agencies and environmental organizations' ability to monitor and regulate water extraction activities. Without access to detailed information, we cannot ensure responsible water usage or address potential environmental harm caused by excessive extraction. Moreover, the confidentiality of major water users' information could facilitate undisclosed water exportation agreements, allowing precious resources to be transferred out of state without public knowledge or scrutiny. This lack of transparency poses a threat to local ecosystems, water security, and community well-being. While Missouri may not currently face severe water scarcity issues, proactive measures are necessary to address future challenges.
