Approaching the issue of delinquent youth straight on in a targeted manner as opposed to enacting broad restrictions on all youth and their parents is the correct way to approach this problem. I thank the representatives for sponsoring these bills and thank the committee for allowing the conversation to begin. Given my volunteer role with WGR I focused in on the 571.077 portion of the bill(s). I shared the language of HB 2880 & HB 2881 with my MO members and we had quite the discussion trying to figure out whether or not a parent could get wrongfully snared by the current wording of the language in section 571.077. However, I did assure them that Rep. Lovasco is very diligent when it comes to ferreting out troublesome language, so I had them share their questions/concerns and I reach out to him with them. Having it confirmed that any parental charge is only on the table IF the child has already been adjudicated a delinquent, along with an understanding that possible self-defense situations would be addressed, has put my mind at ease. After sharing bill sponsor's responses to our concerns with members there have been no further questions raised among them. Speaking only for myself and not WGR-MO as a whole, I am now in support of HB 2880 & HB 2881 and look forward to staying on top of any language changes as they proceed.
