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Schools that are high performing should have the autonomy to assess student growth in a way that is most informative to them. Most high performing schools use more frequent examination of data to examine student growth and to inform instructional decisions such as NWEA, Fastbridge, STAR, etc. These assessments can be given multiple times throughout the year and many high-performing schools use these scores to inform their MTSS (Multi-tiered Systems of Support) process and directly alter instruction to meet student needs. This kind of data is much more meaningful than a yearly state assessment that does not yield informative instructional data on a per student basis. Giving districts autonomy to choose how to assess student growth and teacher performance should reduce student test fatigue and increase motivation, because teachers will have more time to teach and students will have more time to learn.

HB 2937 proposes to give families control of public money dedicated to funding education expenses of K-12 students in Missouri as monitored by the state treasurer, when in fact it creates a surveillance tool for what parents do to educate their school-aged children, and restricts the categories of expenditures in which the money can be spent. The underlying assumption of the bill is that children are "creatures" of the state, when in fact, the state did not "create" a child and has no business replacing or restricting parents in determining the education of children. The requirement that participating students must take state achievement tests and provide for value added assessment in grades that require statewide assessment is seriously flawed by the fact that legislators don't know whether the statewide assessments (which DESE has not made accessible to the public for review as it had in previous iterations of the MAP) is measuring academics or whether they incorporate assessment of psychological and cultural preferences of the test makers. A better solution to restoring parent authority over children's education is to reduce state taxes, allow families to itemize tax deductions, and encourage charter and private schools to create their own scholarship programs that parents can apply for on behalf of their children. Dear Committee, thank you for allowing me to write in to provide information on HB 2937, Much confusion has been caused in the homeschool community as proposals come into bills to rename or reclassify a type of home educator. We traditional homeschoolers value our freedom in raising our children. To that end, I'd like to thank the bill sponsor for purposely prohibiting home schoolers from participating. The invention of the FPE schooler, while a wonderful idea, has brought no end of trouble and division amongst home schoolers. This division is caused because no one can definitively say whether FPE is a type of homeschooler or a separated other type of education entity which learns at home. I'd like to take time to formally propose solutions. I would argue that you could change the definition of FPE a tad as the nature of this program is to use funds to purchase curriculum, books, and the like for the purpose of educating children. Also, the students must take norm-referenced tests as part of the program, so they don't necessarily have to have evaluations. You could change it to something like having to use a written curriculum or combination of curriculums to teach the five subjects, keep a portfolio of samples, and participate in norm-referenced testing. I would also like to see some sort of sign up, contract, or enrolling into the program in order to be an FPE student. And upon commencement of said contract, a student's designation as a home school student is terminated. I think language such as this would make for specific boundaries noticeable between the two types of education at home under a parent's direction.

I am testifying on behalf of Missouri Homeschool Alliance, a registered not-for-profit state-wide homeschool support and advocacy organization. MHA continues to maintain our consistent position that public money should never go to fund private education of any kind. That said, we recognize that this bill is defining a homeschool into a new statute. We appreciate the efforts to differentiate between a homeschool and a FPE school, and the firm definition that FPE is not in any way a homeschool. That said, we recognize that the use of such similar language to define the two separate types of statutory schools, and the near-identical record keeping requirements as currently described in HB 2937, have caused considerable confusion within the homeschooling community. We would ask that the committee consider amending the bill to provide even more distinction between home schools and FPE schools. recognizing that an FPE school will be subject to registration with the State and standardized testing. One such modification could be the inclusion of a termination of homeschooling clause for families who choose to switch from traditional statutory homeschooling to become an FPE School that accepts funding. We would also invite you to consider that, since FPE schools will be subject to standardized testing requirements and use of state-approved curriculum, the requirements for keeping daily lesson plans, record of progress, and portfolio of samples could likely be dropped from FPE requirements. This separation of requirements for the two types of schools would help to clarify to all that homeschool and FPE school are separate entities, and should not in any way be equated. We appreciate the efforts by the members of this Committee to listen, to help to preserve homeschool freedom, and to continue to keep Missouri one of the best states in the Nation in which to homeschool our children.
