I am writing to express my STRONG OPPOSITION to the proposed bill HJR 119, sponsored by Rep. Dave Hinman in the 102nd General Assembly.HJR 119 proposes an amendment to the Constitution of Missouri that, upon voter approval, increases the threshold for any measure referred to the people to be in excess of a majority of votes statewide, and in a majority of the state Senate districts for approval. This bill undermines the principle of "one person, one vote" by giving disproportionate power to certain districts, regardless of their population size. This is gross government overreach, and instead of helping residents of this great state, individuals elected by the people are trying to use their position to silence not only their own constituents, but every legal resident of the state of Missouri as well. The citizens of the great state of Missouri deserve to be represented fairly and have their freedoms preserved. This amendment instead treats constituents as subjects to be ruled over, and goes against everything this state stands for and is an attempt to chip away at the freedoms of legal United States citizens who are Missouri residents. Furthermore, this bill could potentially disenfranchise many Missouri residents. The actual effect of the bill would be to limit the ability of Missouri citizens to effect change through the ballot box. It is the role of the legislature to ensure that the rights and freedoms of all Missouri residents are preserved. HJR 76 does the opposite, and as such I urge you to oppose this bill, and instead focus on legislation that preserves the rights and freedoms of all Missouri residents. I'm not opposed to the Secretary of State public comment period but is unclear what will be done with those comments. Part of the representing us is accepting the responsibility to inform us of important issues and requires no legislation to implement. Using district emails and/or social media to provide factual, non-bias information would be helpful. Restating existing citizenship language is unnecessary, confuses voters, and implies we have non-citizens voting in Missouri. WE DO NOT. Currently:1) MO voters must be a US citizen and MO resident & non-citizens cannot vote in MO at any level of election and 2) No local election officials have authority to violate the MO Constitution and change their local rules. I welcome a bill sponsor to correct me on this point. Based on the House hearing held last week 1,393 pages of witness testimony submitted, 98.7% of it in opposition! THAT's a majority. Missourians are sending clear communication to leave the IP process alone! Thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony; I URGE you to vote NO.

Centers for Independent Living are unique because more than 50% of our board and staff are people with disabilities. To carry out our mission, it is essential that the voices of people with disabilities be heard and valued in local, state, and federal government proceedings. We oppose HJR 119. The initiative petition process is one of the only avenues open to people with disabilities after we have brought concerns to the General Assembly year after year but see no action to solve the problems we share. Repeatedly we expressed the suffering associated with lack of affordable health insurance and wages too low to pay for food and shelter. When the General assembly took no action to help, we worked with our allies to win changes by initiative petition. In the past and continuing today, we sound the alarm about the lack of affordable, healthy, and accessible housing and public transportation in Missouri. It would be an uphill climb to put a solution to these problems on a ballot by initiative petition, let alone to secure a simple majority of voters, but we want to preserve that option. Those who are not U.S. citizens cannot vote in Missouri. Including in the HJR - especially if it is the lead item in the ballot language - is apt to confuse voters.

This House Joint Resolution to authorize a referendum on citizen-led ballot initiatives threatens the ability of Missouri citizens to participate in our state democracy. Proposing a higher bar for voters than what is currently needed to amend the Missouri Constitution by requiring 55% of voters to approve any constitutional amendment initiated by the people rather than the current simple majority of voters endangers the people's reserved power to propose and enact or reject amendments to the constitution by the initiative, independent of the general assembly. Furthermore, requiring a comment period coordinated by the Secretary of State in each congressional district after the petitions have been filed adds an additional and unnecessary hurdle for Missouri citizens petitioning their government. Adding "ballot candy" that specifies only citizens of the United States of America who are residents of the state of Missouri and who are properly registered to vote in the state of Missouri shall be considered legal voters misleads voters into thinking this is not already the requirement to register to vote. Some of the best of what Missouri has to offer has come from citizen-led ballot initiatives, such as the Parks, Soils and Water sales tax that funds our world class state parks. On behalf of the almost 3,000 members of Missouri Parks Association who enjoy and invest in Missouri, we oppose HJR 119 and any legislation that would put a citizen's right to participate in our democracy in jeopardy. Do not advance HJR 119.

Chair, Vice-Chair, members of the committee; thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony today in opposition to HJRs 72 and 102, and HB 1749 which would squander the opportunity for the working people and families of the Show me state to effectively participate in their own democracy. Abortion Action Missouri, formerly Pro Choice Missouri, works to protect and expand every Missourians' right to bodily autonomy, to access essential reproductive healthcare including abortion care, to access accurate information to make the best decisions for ourselves and our families, and to parent our children in safety and dignity. 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The League of Women Voters believes responsible government should be responsive to the will of the people. The citizen initiative petition is the most direct form of voter participation in our democracy and is only used when the citizens feel their voice isn't being heard. This valuable and trusted process has been enshrined in the Missouri Constitution for more than 100 years and has been used for both conservative and progressive issues. It is already a complicated and difficult process to get the thousands of signatures required to get an initiative on the ballot. Making the process even more difficult for no good reason takes away the people's voice. It would end majority rule by increasing the threshold for passage of constitutional IPs to 55%. Moreover, this legislation refers only to citizen initiatives and doesn't include ballot issues proposed by the legislature to be subject to the same percentage to pass. That would give all the power to the legislature and take away the voice of the people. Ironically, it would take not much more than 100 votes in the legislature to put this proposed initiative on a statewide ballot and a simple majority to pass it. This joint resolution also includes a requirement for a person to be a citizen of the United States in order to vote which is unnecessary since that is already required to vote. In summary, the League of Women Voters of Missouri opposes any attempts to make it more difficult to get a measure on the ballot or to raise the threshold for approval.

I am the Rey, Dr. Teresa Danieley, a lifelong Missourian, I have participated in grassroots initiative petition campaigns many times as both a volunteer from 2005 to 2012 and as a staff person at Missouri Jobs with Justice since 2017. I first participated in gathering signatures to raise the minimum wage in 2005-2006 because, as a parish priest in the City of St. Louis, I encountered many parishioners and members of the wider community who were working for minimum wage, but struggling to make ends meet. Raising the minimum wage seemed like a common sense way to alleviate suffering and the need for working people to seek charity. In November 2006, that first increase in the minimum wage won easily statewide, across geographic and political boundaries. The initiative petition process is nonpartisan and used by people across the political and philosophical spectrum. Since that first experience with the Missouri initiative petition process, I have participated again many times, as both a volunteer and a staff person. I have spent all day outside polling places and along parade routes in blazing heat and freezing cold. I have collected signatures in churches, synagogues, mosques, and union halls. Even in the nicest weather with the friendliest crowd, the signature gathering is slow, tedious work, filling pages ten signatures at a time. In the past year, I have also been notarizing initiative petitions and found that it is more complex to notarize an initiative petition than it is to notarize someone's advance health directive. One small mistake on my part could disqualify the signatures of ten Missouri voters and the hard work of a signature gathering volunteer. As a Missourian, I am proud that we have had the grassroots ballot initiative petition process available to us since 1907 as an important tool of direct democracy. The initiative petition process allows us to maintain our freedom to have a say on important issues. Qualifying a grassroots ballot initiative is already incredibly difficult. Making it even more difficult does nothing other than undermine democracy. As a Missouri voter, I have had the right to directly petition my neighbors if I thought our government wasn't prioritizing the right things. This right was passed down to me from previous generations of Missourians. It is part of our toolkit of democracy. If this legislation is to pass, future generations will not have the same rights that I do. We should not seek to permanently alter our constitution and deprive future citizens of the rights we all currently enjoy. A majority is 50% plus 1. Changing the threshold is undemocratic and would make it harder for the public to make decisions. As I have described from my own experience, the initiative petition process is already rigorous and incredibly difficult - hundreds of thousands of voters must sign on before a measure even gets considered for the ballot. Adding additional barriers does nothing more than censure the voice of the people.I respectfully request that you vote no on undermining majority rule. One person, one vote.

As the largest and oldest anti-poverty non-profit in our state, Empower Missouri is committed to improving the quality of life for all Missouri residents through advocacy. On behalf of our staff, board, and coalition members, we express our opposition to HB 1749, HJR 76, HJR 86, and HJR 119. We respectfully ask this committee not to advance any legislation which will alter the initiative petition process, including the slate of bills before it today. The initiative petition process is foundational to the Missouri law making process and ensures each Missourian has a voice in the laws that govern our state. Proposals that seek to alter this one person, one vote tradition are fundamentally undemocratic. They will further polarize our community and frustrate citizens who do not feel represented in state policymaking. The initiative petition process is costly, time consuming, and by no means does it guarantee success. Since 1910, 68 proposed constitutional amendments have been added to the ballot after signature gathering. In total, 41 percent of these ballot measures have been met with a simple majority of voter approval. This means that only 28 constitutional amendments introduced through the initiative petition process have been approved by Missouri voters per our analysis of past election records. The initiative petition process is one of the most important avenues for Missourians to directly engage in shaping the laws that govern our state. The bills being considered here today propose changes that will effectively exclude regular citizens from accessing the initiative petition process. Please do not take this important democratic tool away from Missourians. We respectfully request your no vote on HB 1749, HJR 76, HJR 86, and HJR 119.

Representative Hinman deserves at least a modicum of respect for making his opposition to democracy clear by straight-forwardly adding a super-majority requirement for proposals put on the ballot by the people of Missouri. That does not alter the fact that his proposed amendment is an attack on the principles on which our government here in Missouri was founded. As stated in Article I. Section One of our Constitution: "All political power is vested in and derived from the people. All government of right originates from the people, is founded upon their will only, and is instituted for the good of the whole."There is a name for that form of government. It is called a democracy. A government that fully lives up to those ideals would be a perfect democracy. All political power should be vested in and derived from the people. That is not the case here in Missouri or in America today. Common sense tells us, and research confirms, that "The preferences of the average American appear to have only a miniscule, near-zero, statistically non-significant impact upon public policy." The people of Missouri have some power to "originate" legislation thanks to an amendment to the Missouri constitution that was enacted in 1908, which gave the people of Missouri the power "to propose and enact or reject laws and amendments to the constitution by the initiative, independent of the general assembly". [Article III, Section 49.] However, it is extremely difficult to get proposals on the ballot through the initiative. Now some members of the General Assembly want to make it even harder. I would like to close out my testimony here today by referencing a few comments about democracy made long ago by the Founders of our great nation: The Declaration of Independence states that governments derive their "just powers from the consent of the governed." James Madison agreed, saying that "the vital principle of free government" is "that those who are to be bound by laws, ought to have a voice in making them."Thomas Jefferson stated clearly, "It is my principle that the will of the majority should always prevail."In Federalist Number 22, Alexander Hamilton wrote that, "To give a minority a negative upon the majority (which is always the case where more than a majority is requisite to a decision) is...to subject the sense of the greater number to that of the lesser."James Madison stated that "the vital principle of republican government is the will of the people." And "Every friend to Republican Government ought to raise his voice against the sweeping denunciation of majority Governments."I agree. If you do not support majority rule, you do not believe in democracy.
