We are guided by Jewish values to improve the lives of women, children, and families through direct services, education, advocacy, and philanthropy, while safeguarding individual and civil rights.HJR 131, if approved by voters, would amend the Missouri Constitution to prohibit abortion except in case of medical emergency and would criminalize any person who violates the amendment. Further, it would also prevent this body from passing any legislation that would create any further exceptions to the prohibition of abortion unless they are also put to another vote to amend the constitution. Abortion is already banned in Missouri except for medical emergencies. This ban already hurts pregnant people and families in Missouri and its imposition has had ripple effects through the medical field. A constitutional amendment to enshrine this ban in our constitution is not only unnecessary, it is cruel and the process to try to pass it would be an extraordinary waste of our state's resources. Abortion is essential, important, and necessary healthcare. No one but pregnant people should be making such intimate and private decisions about their health, their bodies, their lives and their futures. NCJWSTL urges you to vote NO on HJR 131.

Every female person has the right to make decisions about her own body, including the right to make a decision whether to bear children. I urge you to oppose HJR131 (Sparks), which proposes to place a constitutional amendment on the Missouri ballot to strengthen the state's current abortion ban by charging abortion providers with serious felonies and enshrining into the Missouri constitution that the General Assembly cannot add any further exceptions to the abortion ban, such as exceptions for cases of rape or incest, SJR87 also includes a provision which would allow for tax credits for contributions made to "nonprofit pregnancy resource centers". These nonprofit resource centers are the religiously affiliated crisis pregnancy centers, also known as CPCs or "fake" clinics. These fake clinics don't provide abortion or offer a full range of health care, and they won't give you honest facts about sexual health and your pregnancy options. Their goal is to spread misinformation and propaganda. Most are not legitimate medical clinics and don't follow HIPAA and keep your information private, often giving it to anti-abortion organizations or using it to harass you. This resolution is a political trick to place a measure on the ballot to compete against the initiative petition backed by abortion advocacy groups that is currently gathering signatures. HJR131 includes deceptive "ballot candy" language, asking voters if the Missouri Constitution should be amended to "guarantee that abortion laws protect pregnant mothers from serious risk", and "authorize support to pregnant mothers". Statements that seem agreeable but hide the true nature of the proposed amendment. Abortion is healthcare and must be fully restored, not further restricted. Chair, Vice-Chair, members of the committee; thank you for the opportunity to testify today in opposition to HJR 131. Abortion Action Missouri works to protect and expand every Missourians' right to bodily autonomy, to access essential reproductive healthcare including abortion care, to access accurate information to make the best decisions for ourselves and our families, and to parent our children in safety and dignity. Abortion is safe, abortion is normal, and access to abortion is popular. The supermajority party leaders of both chambers in this body have said as much out loud- that they know that if the question of the right to abortion is put to the people of the Show Me State-that Missourians will vote in favor of abortion access.Let's talk about why that is- People choose abortions for all sorts of reasons. People choose abortion out of love for themselves, their families, their dreams, their future. The nation's leading providers of women's health care, the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, in a clinical guidance document, writes that "all terminations are medically indicated" meaning all abortions, no matter the individual's reason, are medically necessary. Yet politicians think they have the clinical and scientific, and indeed moral expertise to justify further intrusion into individuals' decision-making. Abortion is critical and essential healthcare, and bans on abortion have a rippling effect throughout medicine. Black people, and people of color, people surviving economic insecurity, LGBTQ+ folks, and people with disabilities are among those hit hardest by existing barriers to reproductive health care including abortion. Our leaders should be focused on closing existing gaps and disparities in access to health care— not exacerbating these gaps to satisfy craven political ambition. Bans on abortion and restrictions on all forms of sexual and reproductive health care are directly correlated to high rates of maternal and infant mortality; so it is no surprise that Missouri, with some of the highest numbers of medically unnecessary restrictions on access to abortion care (even prior to our total abortion ban) also has some of the highest rates of maternal and birthing parent mortality, nationwide. Missouri ranks 44th in the country for maternal mortality and Black birthing parents are 3-4 times more likely to die within a year of pregnancy than their white counterparts. In 2020, maternal/ birthing parent death rates in states with the most restrictions on access to abortion were 62% higher than states with access to abortion care. In short; restrictions on reproductive health care access lead to poor reproductive health outcomes. For many reasons, including structural racism and implicit bias in medicine, the closure of TEN rural hospitals in MO since 2014, a growing number of people falling in the insurance gap, and continued attacks on abortion and reproductive healthcare access, the maternal and infant mortality rates in MO continue to top national and international charts., The largest study of the long term effects of being denied an abortion, the Turnaway Study, found that people forced to continue unintended pregnancies, and their children, are likely to experience long-term economic insecurity and hardship. People denied abortions are also

likely to experience future birthing complications and to remain in contact with abusive partners. This same comprehensive study, that took place over 10 years, found that people who were denied abortions and went on to give birth experienced an increase in household poverty lasting at least four years relative to those who received an abortion. In May 2021, Abortion Action Missouri Foundation (then NARAL Pro-Choice Missouri Foundation), the Office of the City of St. Louis Treasurer Adam Layne, and the Office of the City of St. Louis Mayor Tishaura Jones jointly released a report on the economic impact of Missouri's 2019 abortion ban HB126 underscoring how restrictions on abortion compound racial health inequalities, further financial barriers to accessing care, and widen the gaps in economic stability, education, and housing. Restricting access to abortion disproportionately affects people who already face barriers to high-quality healthcare - immigrants, Black people and people of color, people struggling to survive on low-incomes, and people who are transgender and gender nonconforming, and youth. These communities face increased barriers to accessing safe and affordable reproductive healthcare including abortion care, and pregnancy care, thus worsening entrenched health, economic, racial, and gender inequities. Pregnancy, abortion, miscarriage, fertility struggles and beyond are universal experiences—but because of decades of disinformation, stigmatization, and fear incited by anti- abortion actors like those behind these bills, Missourians are scared to identify with and even talk about these experiences openly. Missourians are in crisis- and you are wasting time and resources to instill further fear and confusion. People may have complex and nuanced opinions about abortion- but Missouri Republicans, Democrats, Independents, and everyone in-between overwhelmingly agree- decisions about pregnancy, including miscarriage management, abortion, fertility care, and beyond, should be left between patients, their families, and their doctors-NOT their politicians. Do not make a further mockery of Missouri's political process on a national stage by advancing this bill. Vote NO.

I urge you to oppose HJR131 (Sparks), which proposes to place a constitutional amendment on the Missouri ballot to strengthen the state's current abortion ban by charging abortion providers with serious felonies and enshrining into the Missouri constitution that the General Assembly cannot add any further exceptions to the abortion ban, such as exceptions for cases of rape or incest, SJR87 also includes a provision which would allow for tax credits for contributions made to "nonprofit pregnancy resource centers". These nonprofit resource centers are the religiously affiliated crisis pregnancy centers, also known as CPCs or "fake" clinics. These fake clinics don't provide abortion or offer a full range of health care, and they won't give you honest facts about sexual health and your pregnancy options. Their goal is to spread misinformation and propaganda. Most are not legitimate medical clinics and don't follow HIPAA and keep your information private, often giving it to anti-abortion organizations or using it to harass you. This resolution is a political trick to place a measure on the ballot to compete against the initiative petition backed by abortion advocacy groups that is currently gathering signatures. HJR131 includes deceptive "ballot candy" language, asking voters if the Missouri Constitution should be amended to "guarantee that abortion laws protect pregnant mothers from serious risk", and "authorize support to pregnant mothers".
