The Association opposes the joint resolution. The joint resolution would propose a Constitutional amendment to allow the legislature to eliminate personal property taxes on all farm equipment and motor vehicles. When combined with HB 1669, the fiscal impact is estimated to be a reduction of local property tax revenues and school revenues of up to \$1.6 billion when fully implemented. This reduction in local school revenues will adversely affect public school students and schools across the state.
