1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 2, Page 27, Section 139.053, Line 25, by  
2 inserting after all of said section and line the following:  
3

4 "238.060. 1. There shall be five commissioners of the Kansas City area transportation  
5 authority appointed from within the district established by the compact between the states of  
6 Missouri and Kansas. One commissioner each shall be appointed from Cass, Platte and Clay  
7 counties. One commissioner shall be appointed from a part of Jackson County other than that part  
8 of such county that is within the city of Kansas City, and one commissioner shall be appointed from  
9 the city of Kansas City. The commissioners serving on August 28, 2000, shall serve the remainder  
10 of the term for which they were appointed.

11 2. Within sixty days before the expiration of the term of each commissioner holding office  
12 on August 28, 2000, or any commissioner holding office after August 28, 2000, or within thirty days  
13 after the position of a commissioner shall become vacant, that commissioner's successor shall be  
14 appointed as follows:

15 (1) If the current commissioner or the position which has become vacant was appointed  
16 from Platte or Clay County, the county commission of the county shall submit a panel of three  
17 persons who are residents of that county and of any city, town or village, including the city of  
18 Kansas City, Missouri, that has appropriated funds for operations of the Kansas City area  
19 transportation authority in its current or immediately preceding fiscal year, selected by a majority  
20 vote of the commission, to the mayor of Kansas City, Missouri, who shall appoint a successor from  
21 the panel submitted by the county commission, with the approval of a majority of the members of  
22 the city council of the city of Kansas City, Missouri~~[-a successor]~~;

23 (2) If the current commissioner or the position which has become vacant was appointed  
24 from Cass County, the county commission of the county shall, by a majority vote, submit a panel of  
25 three persons who are residents of the county to the governor. Within thirty days of submission, the  
26 governor shall appoint one person from the panel as commissioner, with the advice and consent of  
27 the senate; provided that, if any panel is not submitted to the governor by the time appointment is  
28 required, the governor shall appoint a qualified person meeting the residency requirements to fill the  
29 vacancy;

1           (3) If the current commissioner or the position which has become vacant was appointed  
2 from Jackson County, the county executive of Jackson County shall appoint a successor who shall  
3 be a resident of any city, town or village, other than the city of Kansas City, Missouri, that has  
4 appropriated funds for operations of the Kansas City area transportation authority in its current or  
5 immediately preceding fiscal year;

6           (4) If the current commissioner or the position which has become vacant was appointed  
7 from Kansas City, Missouri, the mayor of Kansas City, Missouri, shall appoint a successor who is a  
8 resident of that city.

9           3. Each commissioner appointed pursuant to this section shall hold office for a term of four  
10 years or for the unexpired term of his or her predecessor and shall continue in office until his or her  
11 successor has been appointed and has qualified. No person shall serve more than two consecutive  
12 four-year terms as a commissioner, provided that a person appointed to serve the unexpired term of  
13 a predecessor whose remaining term at the time of such appointment is more than two and one-half  
14 years shall only be permitted to serve one additional, consecutive four-year term."; and

16 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
