1 AMEND House Amendment No. _____ to Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for
2 Senate Bill No. 80, Page 3, Line 44, by deleting said line and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "in the financing of an athletic and entertainment facility project.

5 135.1670. 1. As used in this section, the following terms mean:

6 (1) "Economic activities", any of the following:

7 (a) Jobs;

8 (b) Professional sports teams, franchises, or organizations; or

9 (c) Events that use or have used a facility or sports complex used by a professional sports
10 team, franchise, or organization;

11 (2) "Kansas border county", Johnson, Miami, or Wyandotte County in Kansas;

12 [(2)] (3) "Missouri border county", any county with a charter form of government and with
13 more than six hundred thousand but fewer than seven hundred thousand inhabitants, any county of
14 the first classification with more than eighty-three thousand but fewer than ninety-two thousand
15 inhabitants and with a city of the fourth classification with more than four thousand five hundred but
16 fewer than five thousand inhabitants as the county seat, any county of the first classification with
17 more than two hundred thousand but fewer than two hundred sixty thousand inhabitants, or any
18 county of the first classification with more than ninety-two thousand but fewer than one hundred
19 one thousand inhabitants in Missouri.

20 2. If any job that qualifies for a tax credit under sections 100.700 to 100.850 or under
21 sections 135.100 to 135.258, for funding under section 620.1023, or for a tax credit or retention of
22 state withholding taxes under sections 620.2000 to 620.2020, relocates to a Missouri border county
23 from a Kansas border county, no tax credits shall be issued, funding provided, or retention of
24 withholding taxes authorized for such job under such sections.

25 3. If the director of the Missouri department of economic development determines that the
26 state of Kansas has enacted legislation or the governor of Kansas issued an executive order or
27 similar action which prohibits the Kansas Department of Commerce or any other Kansas executive
28 department from providing economic incentives for ~~jobs~~ economic activities that are relocated
29 from a Missouri border county to a Kansas border county, then the director shall execute and deliver

1 to the governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the president pro tempore of the
2 senate a written certification of such determination. Upon the execution and delivery of such
3 written certification and the parties receiving such certification providing a unanimous written
4 affirmation, the provisions of subsection 2 of this section shall be effective unless otherwise
5 provided in this section. The provisions of subsection 2 of this section shall not apply to incentives
6 reserved on behalf of and awarded to Missouri employers prior to the provisions of subsection 2 of
7 this section taking effect.

8 4. If the director of the Missouri department of economic development determines that the
9 Kansas Department of Commerce or any other Kansas executive department is providing economic
10 incentives for ~~[jobs]~~ economic activities that relocate from a Missouri border county to a Kansas
11 border county, then the director shall execute and deliver to the governor, the speaker of the house of
12 representatives, and the president pro tempore of the senate a written certification of such
13 determination. Upon the execution and delivery of such written certification and the parties
14 receiving such certification providing a unanimous written affirmation, the provisions of subsection
15 2 of this section shall not be effective until such time as the director determines that the Kansas
16 Department of Commerce or any other Kansas executive department is not providing economic
17 incentives for ~~[jobs]~~ economic activities that relocate from a Missouri border county to a Kansas
18 border county, and the director has executed and delivered to the governor, the speaker of the house
19 of representatives, and the president pro tempore of the senate a written certification of such
20 determination and the parties receiving such certification provide an unanimous written affirmation.

21 5. The director of the Missouri department of economic development shall notify the revisor
22 of statutes of all changes in whether subsection 2 of this section is effective.

23 6. The provisions of this section shall expire August 28, 2021, unless at such time the
24 provisions of subsection 2 of this section are in effect. If the provisions of this section do not expire
25 on August 28, 2021, the provisions of this section shall expire on August 28, ~~[2025]~~ 2035."; and";
