1 AMEND Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 80, Page 21,  
2 Section 67.3005, Line 77, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "135.1670. 1. As used in this section, the following terms mean:

5 (1) "Economic activities", any of the following:

6 (a) Jobs;

7 (b) Professional sports teams, franchises, or organizations; or

8 (c) Events that use or have used a facility or sports complex used by a professional sports  
9 team, franchise, or organization;

10 (2) "Kansas border county", Johnson, Miami, or Wyandotte County in Kansas;

11 [(2)] (3) "Missouri border county", any county with a charter form of government and with  
12 more than six hundred thousand but fewer than seven hundred thousand inhabitants, any county of  
13 the first classification with more than eighty-three thousand but fewer than ninety-two thousand  
14 inhabitants and with a city of the fourth classification with more than four thousand five hundred but  
15 fewer than five thousand inhabitants as the county seat, any county of the first classification with  
16 more than two hundred thousand but fewer than two hundred sixty thousand inhabitants, or any  
17 county of the first classification with more than ninety-two thousand but fewer than one hundred  
18 one thousand inhabitants in Missouri.

19 2. If any job that qualifies for a tax credit under sections 100.700 to 100.850 or under  
20 sections 135.100 to 135.258, for funding under section 620.1023, or for a tax credit or retention of  
21 state withholding taxes under sections 620.2000 to 620.2020, relocates to a Missouri border county  
22 from a Kansas border county, no tax credits shall be issued, funding provided, or retention of  
23 withholding taxes authorized for such job under such sections.

24 3. If the director of the Missouri department of economic development determines that the  
25 state of Kansas has enacted legislation or the governor of Kansas issued an executive order or  
26 similar action which prohibits the Kansas Department of Commerce or any other Kansas executive  
27 department from providing economic incentives for [jobs] economic activities that are relocated  
28 from a Missouri border county to a Kansas border county, then the director shall execute and deliver  
29 to the governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the president pro tempore of the  
30 senate a written certification of such determination. Upon the execution and delivery of such

1 written certification and the parties receiving such certification providing a unanimous written  
2 affirmation, the provisions of subsection 2 of this section shall be effective unless otherwise  
3 provided in this section. The provisions of subsection 2 of this section shall not apply to incentives  
4 reserved on behalf of and awarded to Missouri employers prior to the provisions of subsection 2 of  
5 this section taking effect.

6 4. If the director of the Missouri department of economic development determines that the  
7 Kansas Department of Commerce or any other Kansas executive department is providing economic  
8 incentives for ~~[jobs]~~ economic activities that relocate from a Missouri border county to a Kansas  
9 border county, then the director shall execute and deliver to the governor, the speaker of the house of  
10 representatives, and the president pro tempore of the senate a written certification of such  
11 determination. Upon the execution and delivery of such written certification and the parties  
12 receiving such certification providing a unanimous written affirmation, the provisions of subsection  
13 2 of this section shall not be effective until such time as the director determines that the Kansas  
14 Department of Commerce or any other Kansas executive department is not providing economic  
15 incentives for ~~[jobs]~~ economic activities that relocate from a Missouri border county to a Kansas  
16 border county, and the director has executed and delivered to the governor, the speaker of the house  
17 of representatives, and the president pro tempore of the senate a written certification of such  
18 determination and the parties receiving such certification provide an unanimous written affirmation.

19 5. The director of the Missouri department of economic development shall notify the revisor  
20 of statutes of all changes in whether subsection 2 of this section is effective.

21 6. The provisions of this section shall expire August 28, 2021, unless at such time the  
22 provisions of subsection 2 of this section are in effect. If the provisions of this section do not expire  
23 on August 28, 2021, the provisions of this section shall expire on August 28, ~~[2025]~~ 2035."; and
