1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 189, Page 114, Section 567.030, Line 20,  
2 by inserting after said section and line the following:

4 "569.086. 1. As used in this section, "critical infrastructure facility" means any of the  
5 following facilities that are under construction or operational: a petroleum or alumina refinery;  
6 critical electric infrastructure, as defined in 18 CFR Section 118.113(c)(3) including, but not limited  
7 to, an electrical power generating facility, substation, switching station, electrical control center, or  
8 electric power lines and associated equipment infrastructure; a chemical, polymer, or rubber  
9 manufacturing facility; a water intake structure, water storage facility, water treatment facility,  
10 wastewater treatment plant, wastewater pumping facility, or pump station; a natural gas compressor  
11 station; a liquid natural gas terminal or storage facility; a telecommunications central switching  
12 office; wireless and wireline telecommunications infrastructure, including cell towers, telephone  
13 poles and lines, including fiber optic lines; a port, railroad switching yard, railroad tracks, trucking  
14 terminal, or other freight transportation facility; a gas processing plant, including a plant used in the  
15 processing, treatment, or fractionation of natural gas or natural gas liquids; a transmission facility  
16 used by a federally licensed radio or television station; a steelmaking facility that uses an electric arc  
17 furnace to make steel; a facility identified and regulated by the United States Department of  
18 Homeland Security Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards (CFATS) program; a dam that is  
19 regulated by the state or federal government; a natural gas distribution utility facility including, but  
20 not limited to, natural gas distribution and transmission mains and services, pipeline  
21 interconnections, a city gate or town border station, metering station, aboveground piping, a  
22 regulator station, and a natural gas storage facility; a crude oil or refined products storage and  
23 distribution facility including, but not limited to, valve sites, pipeline interconnection, pump station,  
24 metering station, below or aboveground pipeline or piping and truck loading or offloading facility, a  
25 grain mill or processing facility; a generation, transmission, or distribution system of broadband  
26 internet access; or any aboveground portion of an oil, gas, hazardous liquid or chemical pipeline,  
27 tank, railroad facility, or other storage facility that is enclosed by a fence, other physical barrier, or is  
28 clearly marked with signs prohibiting trespassing, that are obviously designed to exclude intruders.

29 2. A person commits the offense of trespass on a critical infrastructure facility if he or she  
30 purposely trespasses or enters property containing a critical infrastructure facility without the  
31 permission of the owner of the property or lawful occupant thereof. The offense of trespass on a  
32 critical infrastructure facility is a class B misdemeanor. If it is determined that the intent of the  
33 trespasser is to damage, destroy, or tamper with equipment, or impede or inhibit operations of the  
34 facility, the person shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

35 3. A person commits the offense of damage of a critical infrastructure if he or she purposely  
36 damages, destroys, or tampers with equipment in a critical infrastructure facility. The offense of

1 damage of a critical infrastructure facility is a class D felony.

2 4. This section shall not apply to conduct protected under the Constitution of the United  
3 States, the Constitution of the state of Missouri, or a state or federal law or rule."; and
