2	Page 7, Lines 19-37, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	"313.435. 1. A municipality may adopt an ordinance permitting video lottery game
5	terminals within the corporate limits of such municipality. Such municipality shall notify the
6	commission of the ordinance within seven days of passage and the commission shall not authorize
7	the placement of video lottery terminals within such municipality without such notice of an
8	ordinance permitting video lottery game terminals within the corporate limits of any municipality.
9	A municipality that has adopted such an ordinance may at any time thereafter adopt an ordinance
10	prohibiting video lottery game terminals within the corporate limits of such municipality, provided
11	that such municipality shall notify the commission of the ordinance within seven days of passage of
12	such ordinance at which time the commission shall notify any video lottery game terminals license
13	holders within the municipality that their licenses are no longer valid.
14	2. A county commission may, for the unincorporated area of the county, adopt an ordinance
15	permitting video lottery game terminals within the unincorporated area of the county. Such county
16	shall notify the commission of the ordinance within seven days of passage and the commission shall
17	not authorize the placement of video lottery terminals within such unincorporated area of the county
18	without such notice of an ordinance permitting video lottery game terminals within the
19	unincorporated area of any county. A county commission that has adopted such ordinance may at
20	any time thereafter adopt an ordinance prohibiting video lottery game terminals within the
21	unincorporated area of such county, provided that such county commission shall notify the
22 23	commission of the ordinance within seven days of passage of such ordinance at which time the
23	commission shall notify any video lottery game terminals license holders within the unincorporated
24	area of the county that their licenses are no longer valid.
25	3. Any municipality or county adopting an ordinance that permits or prohibits the licensing
26	of video lottery games shall notify the commission of such action."; and"; and
