"324.1173. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, for purposes of
obtaining a professional or occupational license, a person has demonstrated lawful presence and is
eligible to obtain a professional or occupational license if the person submits:
(1) An unexpired employment authorization document issued by the United States
Department of Homeland Security, Form I-766; and
(2) Documentation issued by the United States Department of Homeland Security, the
United States Citizenship and Immigration Services, or any other federal agency, including a Form
I-797 used by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services, demonstrating that such
person is described in Section 202(c)(2)(B)(i) through (ix) of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005, P.L.
<u>109-13.</u>
2. A professional or occupational license issued to a person eligible pursuant to subsection 1
of this section shall be valid only for the period of time during which such person's employment
authorization document is valid.
3. Nothing in this section shall affect the requirements to obtain a professional or
occupational license that are unrelated to the lawful presence requirements demonstrated pursuant to
this section.
4. Nothing in this section shall be construed to grant eligibility for any public benefits other
than obtaining a professional or occupational license.
5. Any person who has complied with the requirements of this section shall have his or her
employment authorization document verified through the Systematic Alien Verification for
Entitlements Program operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security or an
equivalent program designated by the United States Department of Homeland Security.
<u>6. The general assembly enacts this section pursuant to the authority provided in 8 U.S.C.</u> Section 1621(d), as such section existed on August 28, 2025."; and
Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
