6	and senior services shall establish a dementia services coordinator as a full-time position.

9	(2) Coordinate information resources affecting Missourians living with dementia and their
10	caregivers. Such coordination shall include, but not be limited to:
11	(a) Using dementia-related data to coordinate ways to improve public health outcomes and
12	service delivery for persons with Alzheimer's disease or related dementia;
13	(b) Establishing and maintaining relationships with other agencies, providers, and

16	(c) Supporting the provision of dementia-specific staff training across all relevant state
17	agencies, including law enforcement, the department of health and senior services, and other

22	the quality of care in residential, home-based, and community-based settings;

24	(5) Identify grant opportunities to expand the scope of services for persons living with
25	dementia and their caregivers and apply for the grant opportunities;
