1 AMEND House Committee Substitute No. 2 for House Bill No. 495, Page 7, Section 84.160, Line
2 3, by deleting said line and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 Further amend said bill and section, Page 8, Lines 17-30, by deleting said lines and inserting in lieu
8 thereof the following:

10 "3. It is the duty of the [~~municipal assembly or common council of the cities~~] state to make
11 the necessary appropriation for the expenses of the maintenance of the police force in the manner
12 herein and hereafter provided[; ~~provided, that in no event shall such municipal assembly or common~~
13 ~~council be required to appropriate for such purposes (including, but not limited to, costs of funding~~
14 ~~pensions or retirement plans) for any fiscal year a sum in excess of any limitation imposed by article~~
15 ~~X, section 21, Missouri Constitution; and provided further, that such municipal assembly or~~
16 ~~common council may appropriate a sum in excess of such limitation for any fiscal year by an~~
17 ~~appropriations ordinance enacted in conformity with the provisions of the charter of such cities].";

20 Further amend said bill, Page 55, Section 84.175, Line 17, by inserting after said section and line the
21 following:

23 "[~~84.210. 1. It shall be the duty of said boards, annually on or before the last day of~~
24 ~~February of each year to prepare, in writing, on such forms as may be prescribed for budget~~
25 ~~preparation purposes by such cities for departments of city government, an estimate of the sum of~~
26 ~~money which will be necessary for the subsequent fiscal year, to enable them to discharge the duties~~
27 ~~hereby imposed upon them, and to meet the expenses of the police department. Such estimate shall~~
28 ~~include, but not be limited to, all reasonably anticipated revenues of such boards from all sources~~
29 ~~including, but not limited to, grants from the federal or state governments, governmental agencies or~~
30 ~~other grantors and forfeitures of property and proceeds of forfeited property, a table of organization,~~
31 ~~line items for personnel, supplies, maintenance, repairs, services and contractual requirements, and a~~
32 ~~statement comparing receipts and expenses for the last prior full fiscal year, the current fiscal year,~~
33 ~~and the fiscal year to which the estimate pertains. Said boards shall forthwith certify such estimate~~
34 ~~to the board of common council or municipal assembly, as the case may be, of said cities, who are~~
35 ~~hereby required to set apart and appropriate the amount so certified, payable out of the revenue of~~
36 ~~said cities, after having first deducted the amount necessary to pay the interest upon the~~

1 indebtedness of said cities, the amount necessary for the expenses of the city hospital and health
2 department, the amount necessary for lighting the city, and any sum required by law to be placed to
3 the credit of the sinking fund of said cities. During a fiscal year for which an appropriation has been
4 so made, said boards shall not transfer funds appropriated for one line item of such appropriation to
5 any other line item without the prior approval of the municipal board of estimate and apportionment.

6 ———2. The said boards of police commissioners shall pass upon all claims presented against
7 them for the expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties as herein provided, and shall certify,
8 by their president and secretary, all such claims as are entitled to payment and all salary rolls for
9 salaries as provided in sections 84.010 to 84.340, and such claims and salary rolls, when so certified,
10 shall be duly audited and paid by the proper disbursing officer or officers of said cities within five
11 days after being audited, out of any moneys in the city treasury not appropriated to the specific
12 purposes above enumerated; provided, however, that the amount of said claims and salary rolls so
13 certified shall not exceed, in any one year, the amount so, as aforesaid, estimated for that year to the
14 common council or municipal assembly of said cities aforesaid. The common council or municipal
15 assembly of said cities shall have no power or authority to levy or collect any taxes or appropriate
16 any money for the payment of any police force, other than that organized and employed under
17 sections 84.010 to 84.340. No officer or servant of the mayor or the common council or municipal
18 assembly of said cities shall disburse any money for the payment of any police force other than that
19 organized and employed under sections 84.010 to 84.340, and the power of said mayor and common
20 council or municipal assembly to appropriate and disburse money for the payment of the police
21 force organized and employed under sections 84.010 to 84.340 shall be exercised as in this section
22 directed and not otherwise.]; and
