1 AMEND House Bill No. 1041, Page 2, Section 311.520, Line 29, by inserting after all of said section and line
2 the following:

4 "311.2026. 1. For the purposes of this section, the term "FIFA World Cup Tournament" means the
5 international soccer tournament that takes place every four years and is organized by the Federation
6 Internationale de Football Association.

7 2. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter to the contrary, any person or establishment
8 possessing the qualifications and meeting the requirements of this chapter that is licensed to sell intoxicating
9 liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises in any city, county, district, or other political
10 subdivision in this state may, for the duration of the 2026 FIFA World Cup Tournament, beginning on June
11 11, 2026, through July 19, 2026, operate twenty-four hours a day and sell, serve, and allow for the
12 consumption of alcoholic beverages between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. of the following day. This
13 temporary extension of service hours shall apply to all licensed areas at a licensed establishment. The
14 provisions of this chapter relating to hours of operation, time of closing or opening, or hours of sale of
15 intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises shall not apply to such licensees for
16 the duration of this temporary extension, except as provided under this section.

17 3. Licensees are not required to apply to the commission for approval and no special temporary
18 license or permit shall be required of any licensee for the purposes of this temporary extension, subject to any
19 local restrictions on hours of operation as provided under subsection 4 of this section or additional conditions
20 for compliance under any applicable local laws, ordinances, rules, or regulations.

21 4. If any city, county, district, or other political subdivision in this state objects to the extension of
22 hours for licensees within its jurisdiction, the governing body of such political subdivision may exempt itself
23 by ordinance from the provisions of this section or may modify by ordinance the hours applicable to such
24 political subdivision for the temporary period allowed by this section to be not less than the ordinary
25 permissible hours of service applicable to such political subdivision but not to exceed the hours allowed
26 under this section.

27 5. This section shall expire on July 20, 2026."; and
