1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 916, Page 4, Section 208.247, Line 42, by  
2 inserting after said section and line the following:

3  
4 "213.145. No person's rights, privileges, or access to public services shall be denied or  
5 abridged solely because such person is experiencing homelessness. Such person shall be granted the  
6 same rights and privileges as any other citizen of this state. A person experiencing homelessness  
7 has the following rights:

8 (1) The right to move freely in public spaces, including sidewalks and public buildings,  
9 parks, and transportation;

10 (2) The right to equal treatment by city and state agencies;

11 (3) The right to emergency medical care;

12 (4) The right to a reasonable expectation of privacy for personal property, just as inside a  
13 home;

14 (5) The right to vote, register to vote, and receive documentation necessary to prove  
15 identity; and

16 (6) The right to protection from disclosure of his or her record and information without  
17 appropriate legal authority and the right to confidentiality of personal records."; and

19 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
20 accordingly.
