4	civilly liable for establishing, to ensure privacy and safety, one or more multiple-occupancy
5	restrooms or changing areas designated as follows:
6	(1) For the exclusive use of the male sex; or
7	(2) For the exclusive use of the female sex.
8	3. The provisions of this section shall not apply to individuals entering a multiple-
9	occupancy restroom or changing area designated for use by the opposite sex when entering:
0	(1) For custodial, maintenance, or inspection purposes;
1	(2) To render emergency medical assistance; or
2	(3) As a parent or guardian accompanying their child, who is eight years of age or younger
3	with the permission of the school.
4	4. (1) No political subdivision shall adopt any ordinance, rule, or regulation prohibiting a
5	private school from establishing one or more multiple-occupancy restrooms or changing areas as
6	provided in this section.
7	(2) If a political subdivision adopts an ordinance, rule, or regulation in violation of
8	subdivision (1) of this subsection, such political subdivision shall pay the attorney's fees and costs
9	incurred by a private school in such private school's legal defense against such ordinance, rule, or
