ASSUMPTION

§ 210.203 – Regarding the record of substantiated complaints against child care facilities

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight notes section B adds an emergency clause stating it is necessary to protect the privacy and safety of those persons who file complaints against child care facilities, section A of this proposal is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and section A of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
